WWT will automate a substantial portion of purchases between the OEM and its network of 900 suppliers, who will log on to POC to view and accept purchase orders, to submit invoices for items shipped and to track payments. Since POC is pre-integrated to WWT's Oracle ERP system, all information is in real-time and all of the Oracle setups, configurations and business rules carry over to the ClearOrbit software.
