World Wide Technology sees '06 revenue jump 16%

World Wide Technology Inc. (WWT) said recently that its 2006 revenue reached \$2.1 billion, up more than 16 percent from 2005.

Previously, **the company's revenue had jumped** more than 28 percent to \$1.8 billion in 2005 from \$1.4 billion in 2004.

World Wide Technology (WWT) is a systems integrator that provides technology and supply chain solutions to the commercial, government and telecom sectors.

WWT said in a release that it added more than 420 new customers in 2006.

During the year, WWT won two large IT procurement contracts totaling \$125 million, including a \$15 million **contract with the state of Alaska's Department of Administration** and a \$110 million contract **from the state of Missouri.**

In August, St. Louis-based WWT was awarded a wireless equipment and services contract with the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) for an unspecified amount.

World Wide Technology Inc employs more than 1,000 people and is one of the largest privately held companies in St. Louis.
