World Wide Technology inks deal with Dell

World Wide Technology Inc. has received a contract to provide some supply chain services to Round Rock, Texas-based Dell Computer Corp.

Financial terms were not disclosed.

World Wide Technology will manage and supply Dell's factories with a variety of items from their logistics centers in Austin, Texas; Nashville, Tenn.; and Reno, Nev. It will also perform certain assembly, de-kitting and labeling services for custom components stored in these centers.

The company said it is using wireless technology, business-to-business systems integration and back-office infrastructure to support Dell's manufacturing process.

St. Louis-based World Wide Technology buys and sells information technology products. The company is among the fastest-growing private companies in St. Louis with \$910 million in revenue in 2001.
