### **World Wide Technology named largest black-owned business**

World Wide Technology in Maryland Heights, Mo., will be named the largest black-owned business in the United States by Black Enterprise magazine in its June issue, the magazine said Thursday.

The company ranked highest with sales of \$1.2 billion last year, the magazine said in a statement. The complete list and details will be available later this month.

World Wide distributes information technology products and services. Last year, the company added The Boeing Co., Dell, DaimlerChrysler, EDS and the Transportation Security Administration as clients.

Derek Dingle, executive editor of Black Enterprise, said in a statement, "It's strategy to recombine its World Wide Technology and [Telcobuy.com](http://Telcobuy.com) units as well as aggressively pursue government and corporate contracts paid off handsomely."

Telcobuy, which connects buyers and sellers of telecommunications equipment via the Internet, merged with World Wide last year after being spun off in 1999.
