World Wide's Steward elected to Centene's board

David Steward, chairman and chief executive of World Wide Technology Inc., has been elected to the board of Centene Corp.

Steward founded World Wide Technology in 1990, as well as [Telcobuy.com](#). The privately held company had \$716 million in sales in 2002, and is the 14th largest privately held company in St. Louis.

Steward joins five other independent directors on Centene's board.

Michael Niedorff, president and chief executive of Centene, said in a statement Steward's understanding of the political and social environment in which it operates would be valuable to Centene as it works to become a multi-line government services provider.

St. Louis-based Centene Corp. (Nasdaq: CNTE) provides managed care programs and related services to individuals under Medicaid. It also operates health plans in Wisconsin, Indiana, New Jersey and Texas.
