Largest black-owned company named

World Wide Technology, a systems-integration company based near St. Louis, is the nation's largest African-American-owned company for the second year in a row, with 2004 revenue of \$1.4 billion, according to the June issue of *Black Enterprise* magazine, out May 24. Four black-owned firms have now broken the \$1 billion mark in annual revenue, including Detroit-based Prestige Automotive, which last year became the first black-owned auto dealership to have more than \$1 billion in revenue. The others are TLC Beatrice and CAMAC International.
