The United States Air Force's Global Command and Control System (GCCS) program, headquartered at Hanscom AFB, was in need of a partner to provide centralized product procurement and distribution.

In pursuit of that end, the Air Force awarded World Wide Technology, Inc. (WWT) an IDIQ (indefinite delivery indefinite quantity) Contract supporting the GCCS program. WWT is now the prime contractor providing commercial off-the-shelf hardware, software and services including warehousing, staging, integration and deployment on demand.

This contract supports the Air Force's automated information system designed to support deliberate and crisis planning with the use of an integrated set of analytic tools. Primary solutions are centered around Unix and NT workstations and servers; Oracle database applications, project

collaboration tools and performance reports.

Integration services, which are performed at WWT's integration and distribution center in St. Louis, MO, include imaging and configuration of Sun™ workstations and servers, Dell and Gateway desktops, ruggedized portable laptops, and printers.

WWT's technology solution provides the Air Force with heightened visibility into the order process. Benefits to the GCCS program include centralized distribution of equipment, Web-based reporting, increased on-time deliveries, and maximization of organization-wide productivity.

Additional services provided by WWT include inventory management, asset tracking, asset disposal, staging, asset tagging, equipment deployment, product replacement, and equipment sparing.
